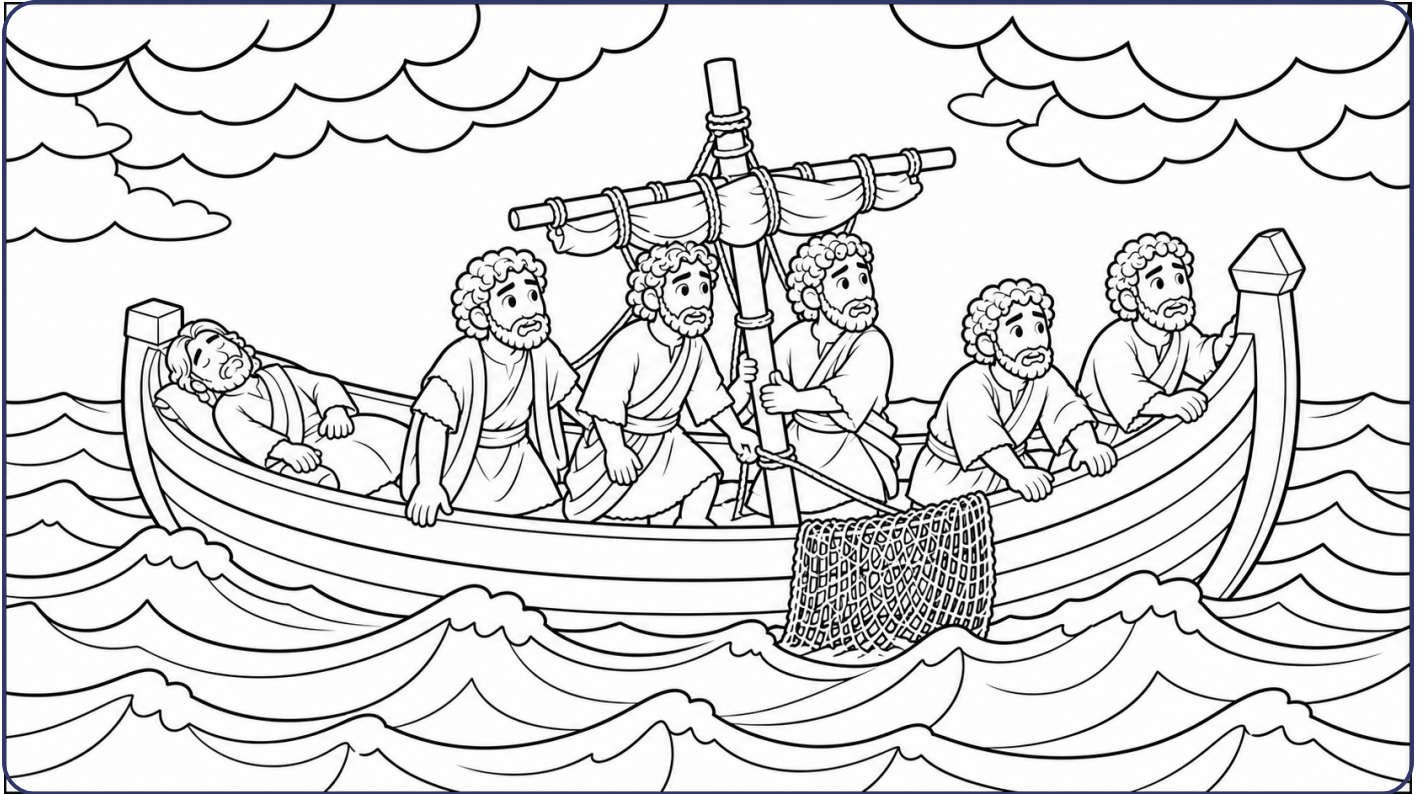

Color the wind, waves, boat, and disciples working together.

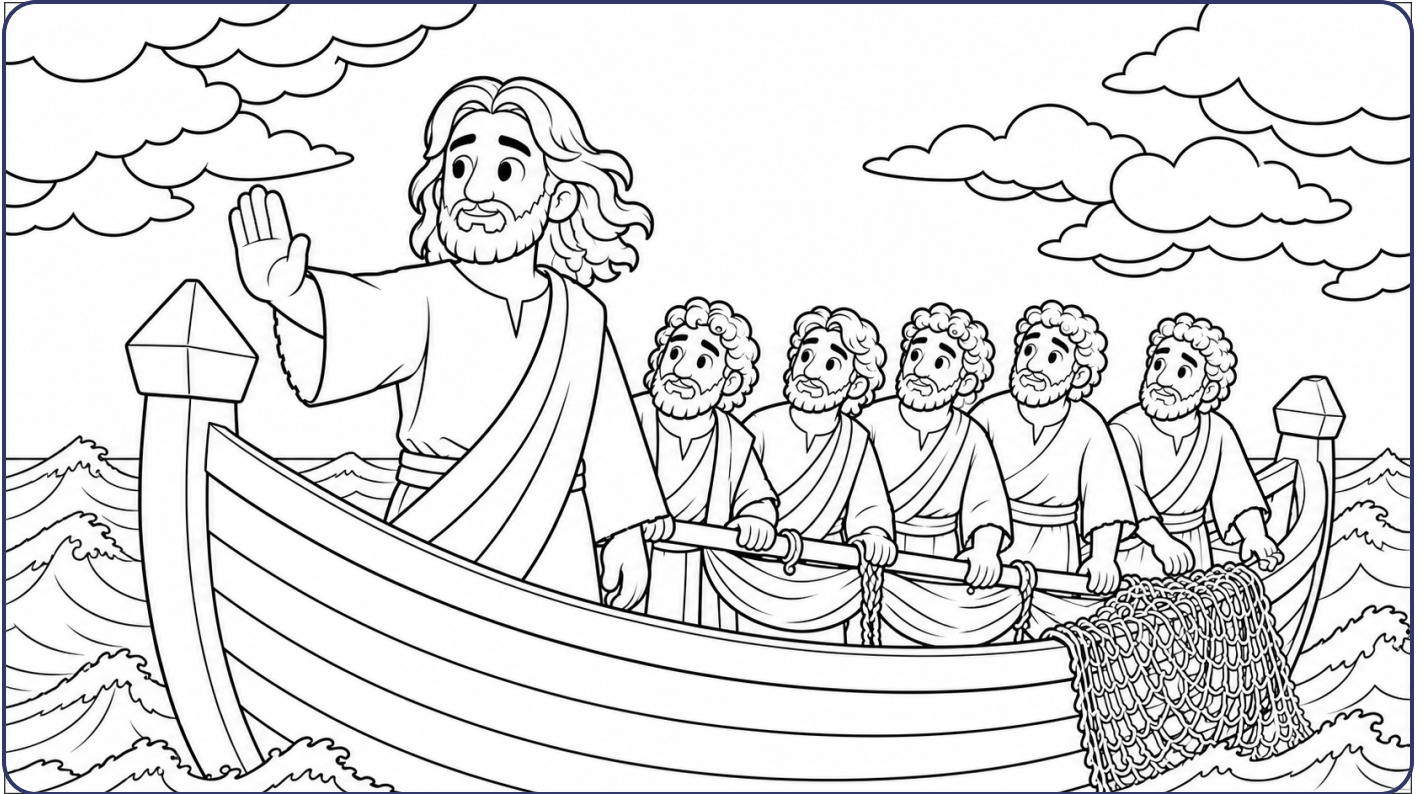


AFTER YOU COLOUR

Color Jesus, the boat, and the storm as He speaks with calm authority.

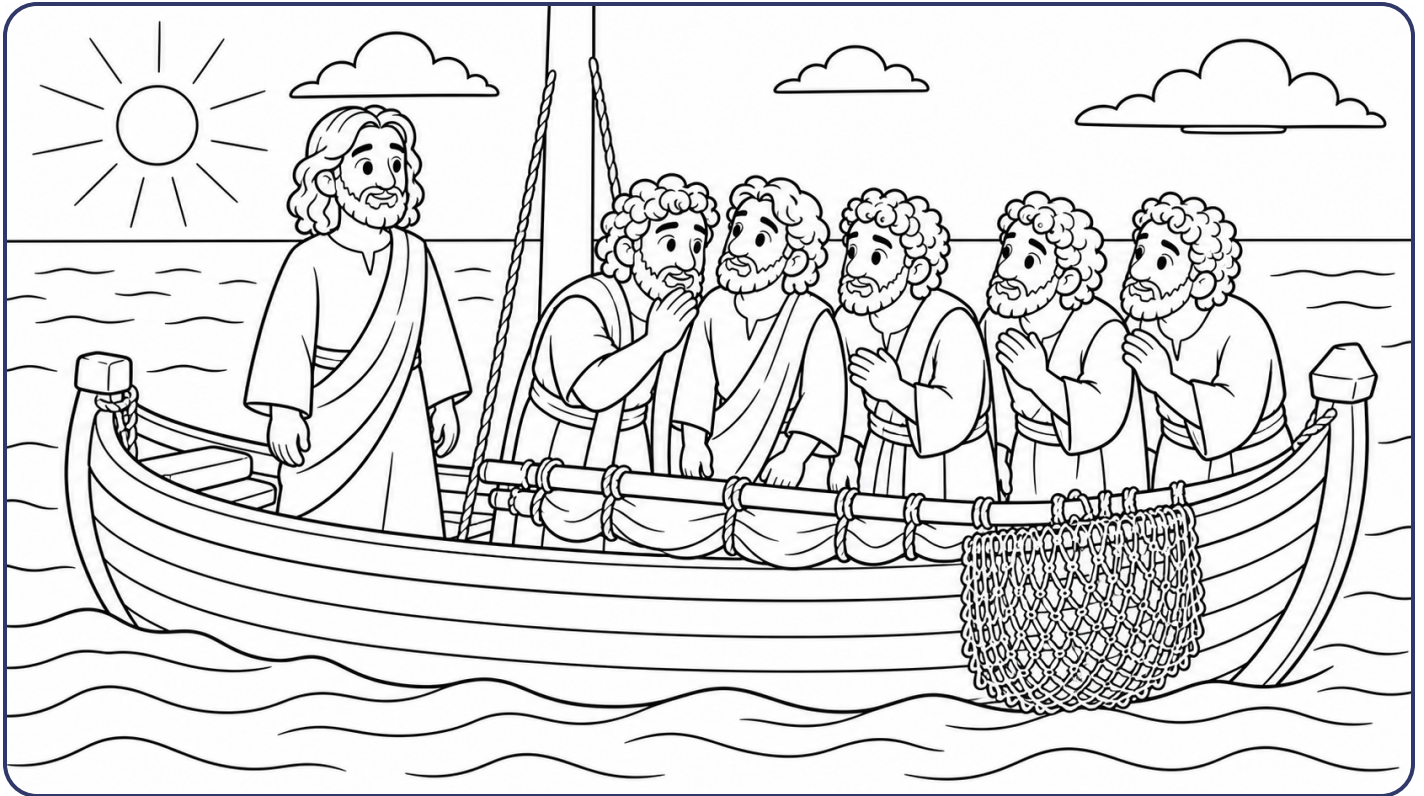

Color Jesus, His amazed friends, and the peaceful water.

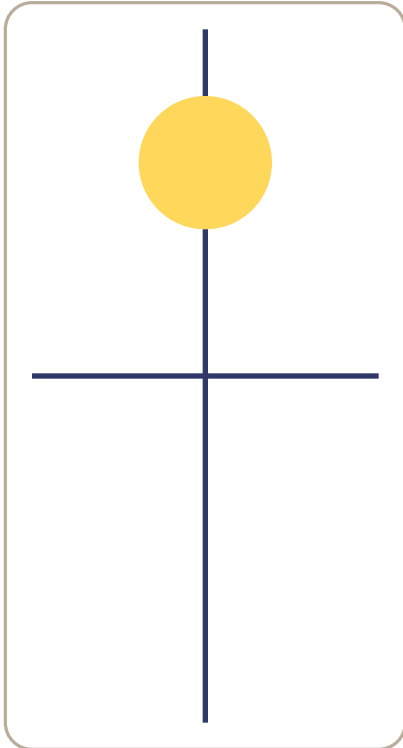

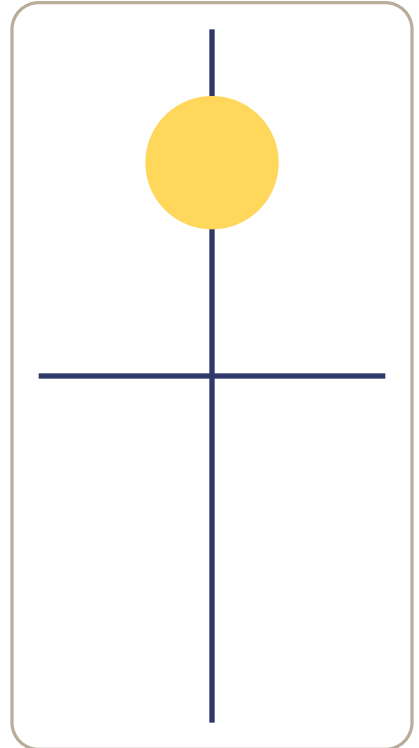

MAZE

Make a Calm-in-the-Storm Boat

Ask an adult to help with scissors. Move the boat from stormy waves to calm water as you retell the story.

SUPPLIES

Cardstock or a paper plate, blue paper strips, crayons, glue, one craft stick, and child-safe scissors.

Color a small boat and glue it to the top of a craft stick.

2

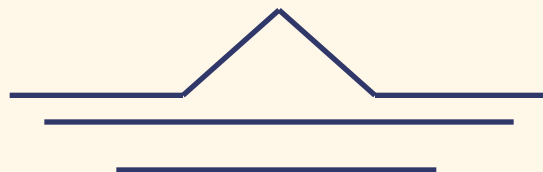
Cut two blue paper strips with gentle wave shapes. Keep the waves wide and easy to hold.

Glue only the side edges of the wave strips so the boat can slide behind them.

Retell the storm, slide the boat to calm water, and say: Jesus is near. I can take the next brave step.

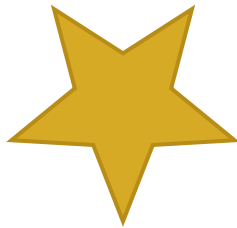
