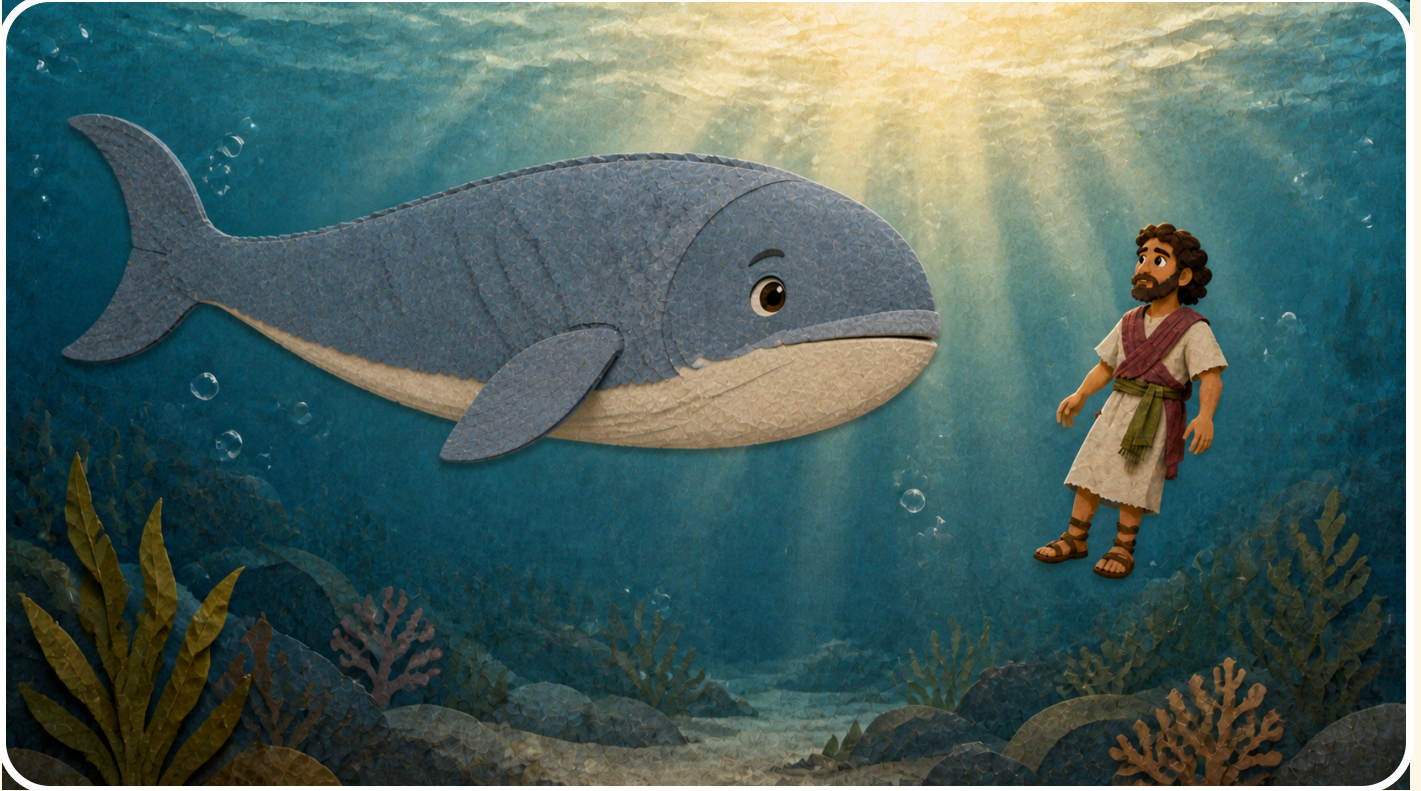


Jonah and the Great Fish

Color Jonah, the hillside, and the path toward his next right step.

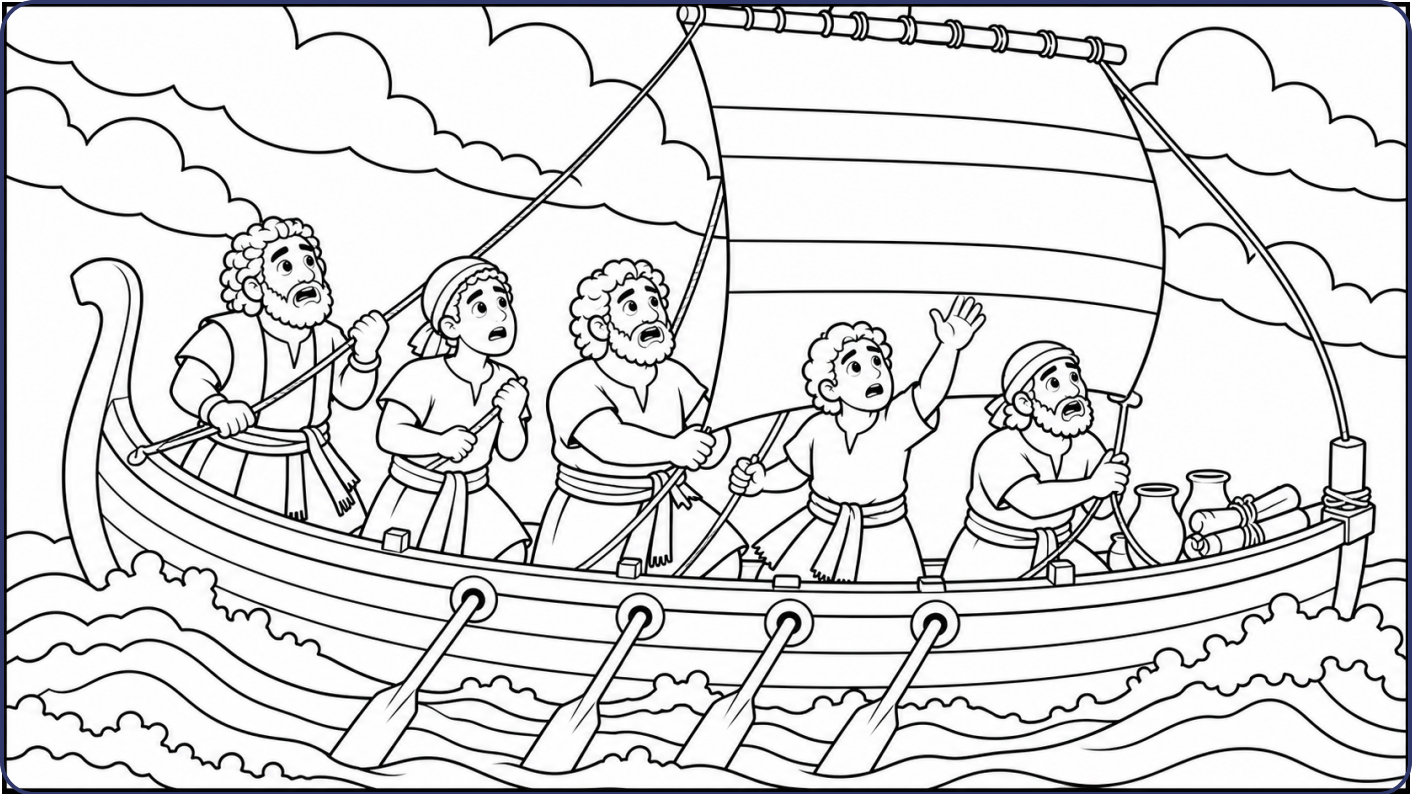


AFTER YOU COLOUR

Color the upright ship, the sailors, the sail, and the waves.

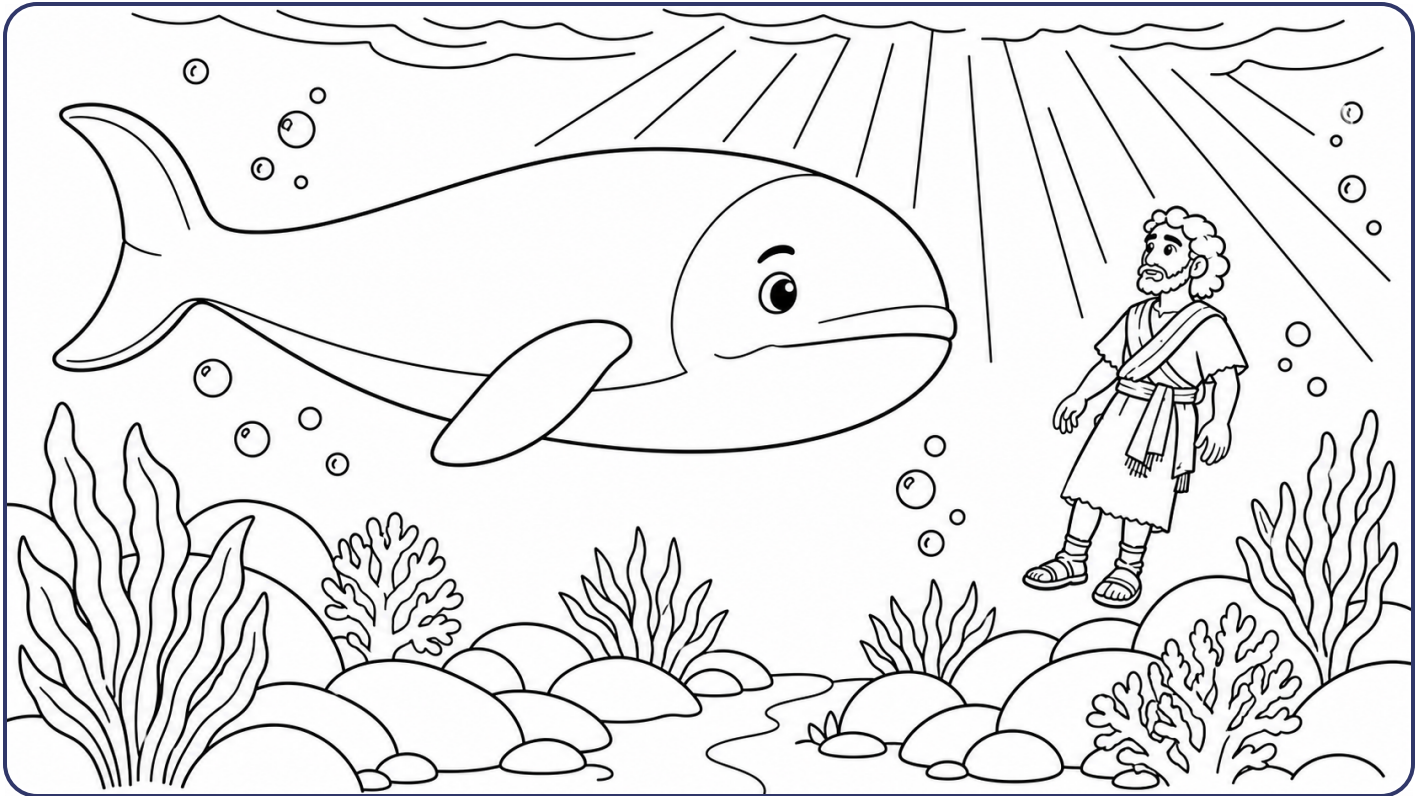


AFTER YOU COLOUR

Color Jonah, the listening families, the king, and the great city gate.

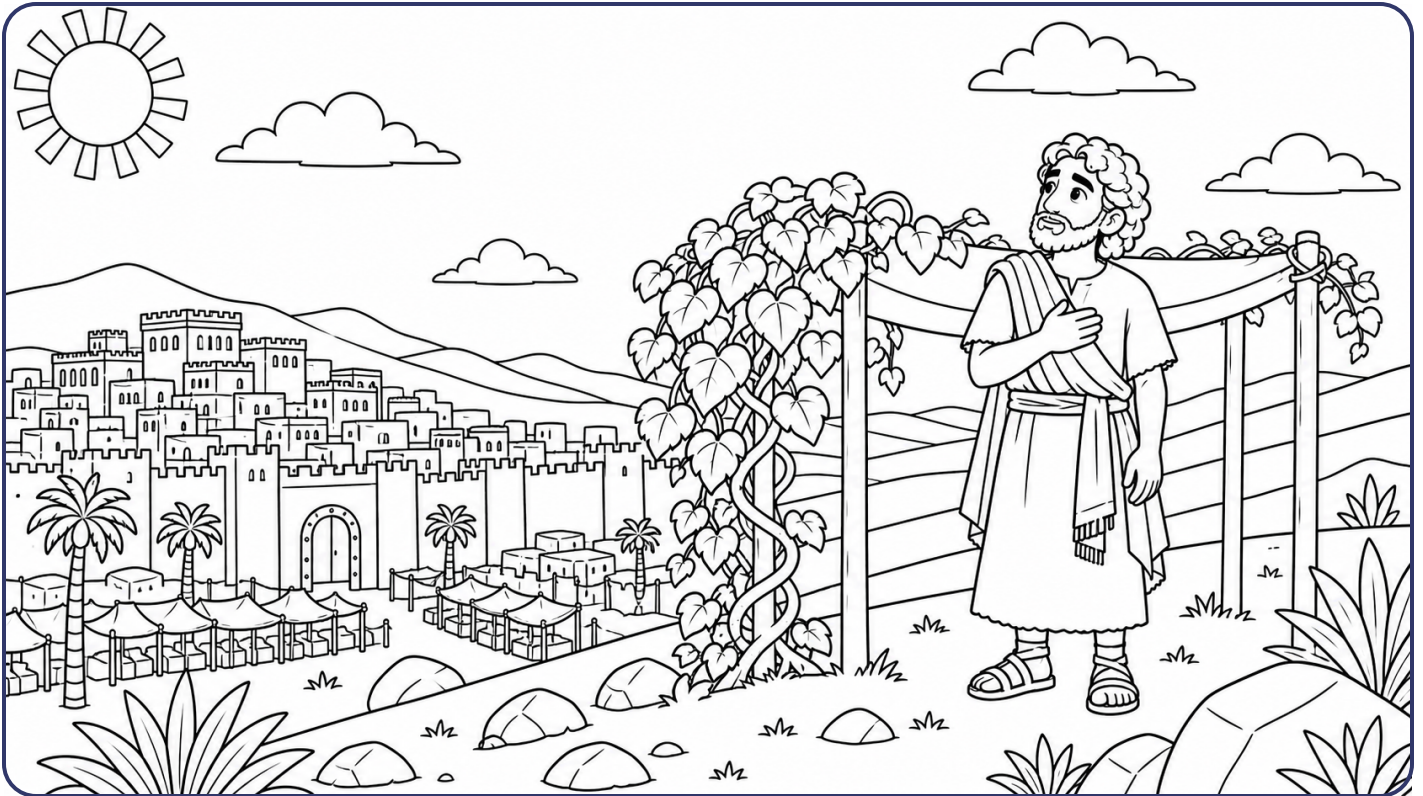


AFTER YOU COLOUR

Color Jonah, the leafy plant, the shelter, and Nineveh below.

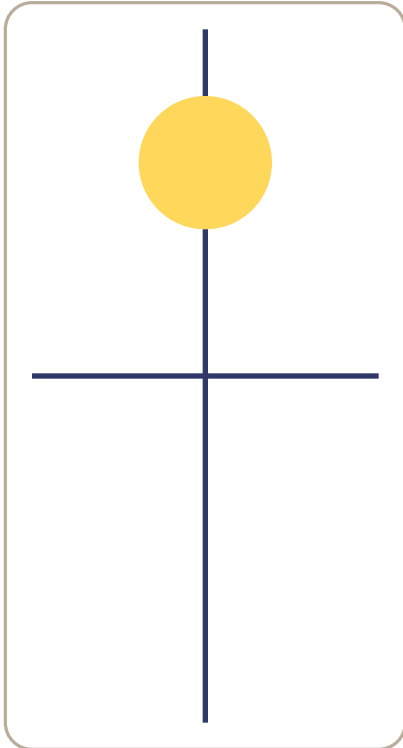

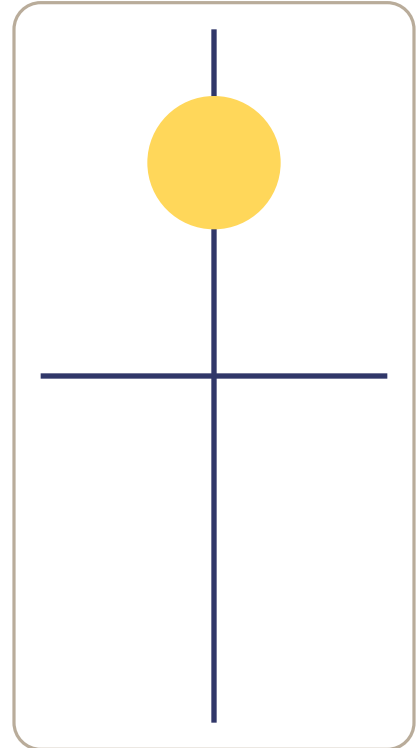

Guide Jonah to Nineveh

Make a Prayer-in-the-Fish Pocket

Ask an adult to help with scissors. Open the fish pocket to remember that Jonah prayed and God heard him.

SUPPLIES

Cardstock or a paper plate, crayons, glue, one small prayer slip, and child-safe scissors.

Fold a paper plate or wide oval of cardstock in half to make a fish-shaped pocket.

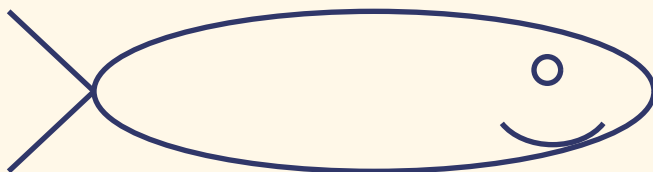
Draw one large kind eye, a curved mouth, fins, and a tail. Decorate both sides with bright colors.

Glue the lower edge, leaving the top open. Ask an adult for help with any cutting.

On the prayer slip, draw one next right step and one person to treat with mercy. Place it inside the fish.

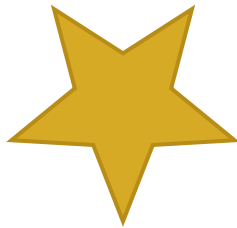
